

Classic Fighters Marlborough 2003

The Theme for 2003 was "Fighters of WW1"



The Star attraction of the Show was 5 Fokker Dr.1 Triplanes in the air at one time. This along with the Special Ground Based attractions made this an excellent spectacle to watch. The loan of an original German WW2 Mercedes staff car and the replica WW1 British tank created by the 'Lord of the Rings' special effects team, made realistic ground scenes to complement the activities above.

Other WW1 aircraft to be seen were Fokker D.VIII, Sopwith Camel, Bristol F2B Fighter, and Airco DH-2

It was the first airshow appearance of the rare Russian Polkarpov PO-2 Biplane just finished. This aircraft is now in England on loan for a few years. The ongoing support and development will see new and interesting aircraft finish restorations and take to the air for future shows.

The location of Marlborough is one of the finest wine areas of NZ along with the superb Sea, River and Lake fishing make this an area of many things to do for all the family and friends of Airshow Visitors.
